Project Objectives, Concept and Vision	BraCC Overall Objective: Increasing people-to-people actions and cross-border cooperation in community initiatives in Timiș, Arad and Csongrád - Csanád Counties, by strengthening the resilience of local rural communities and citizens, especially pupils, teachers, volunteer servants, through building reaction capacities and first aid skills training and tackling CB health insurance in the Euroregion, in order to pave the way to future, more structured, community-led interventions. BraCC Specific Objectives: Consolidation of disaster preparation and management capabilities by purchasing and making available for P2P actions the VR Fire Extinguisher Simulators, first aid family QPCR manikins, Heimlich maneuver vests; Nurturing the P2P contacts, cooperation and the CB culture of prevention and well-being by surveying health insurance systems in the neighboring countries - both in the case of outpatient and inpatient care - and by enabling virtual and classic training modules / joint practicing events for skills development in fire extinguishing, first aid granting, Heimlich maneuver granting by volunteer servants, intervention volunteers, pupils and teachers, and generally speaking civilians from Timis, Arad and Csongrad-Csanad Counties; Integration and use of project communication platform and raising awareness campaigns as digital engines to market for financing program and authorities, project vision and its key messages; Subsidy contract adequate and sustainable execution. Under joint coordination, financial and communication partnership adopted strategies, BRaCC is proposing the execution of following P2P actions: A total of 29 days of raising awareness with 1670 P2P participations, are set to reach cross-border partner counties rural settlements and people, grouping:

	○ volunteer servants training on virtual fire extinguisher use (10 sessions x 1 day x 12 CB volunteer servants and intervention volunteers / session); ○ pupils and teachers training on first aid (10 sessions x 1 day x 25 CB pupils and teachers / session); ○ first aid Caravan (3 days of Caravan, reaching CB rural settlements and 600 citizens at least); ○ building reaction to disasters, climate change acknowledgement, horizontal principles information and dissemination Caravan (3 days of Caravan, reaching CB rural settlements and 600 citizens at least); ○ pupils CB competitions / contests on first aid skills (CB competitions over 3 days, involving at least 100 CB pupils); • Conception and dissemination of 3 min AUDIOBOOK (building reaction in case of disaster, climate change repercussions upon human life) for blind/low vision youth / people; • Conception and dissemination of 3 min VIDEO (building reaction in case of disaster, climate change repercussions upon human life) for youth / people with low hearing acuity; • Integration and use of project social media platform as digital engine to market / to campaign for financing program and authorities, project vision and its key messages, grouped in emergency situations educative audio, video and text input addressed to 3 counties population, targeting further youth involvement and gender mainstreaming in civil protection joint actions, • Conception and dissemination of a study that will set up a gap-filling model on how to organize both the local (GP) CB and the outpatient CB emergency care between the HU settlements from Csongrád-Csanád and the RO settlements from Arad and Timis counties. The study will describe and analyze the current health care situation on the GPs and outpatient care services in the approximate border area between Csongrád-Csanád and Arad, Timis counties and propose model(s) to organize and finance as the cross-border healthcare in area. The study should examine the financing possibilities of the action based on DIRECTIVE 2011/24/EU. It also should deal with patients' data security issues across the border; This project softcore, P2P actions, will be underpinned by the project acquired equipment: ○ VR Fire Extinguisher Simulators (2 pieces to be acquired) meet the training requirements for the civilian population (schools, institutions, etc.) in the area of competence, provide realistic high-resolution scenarios, the practical component, perform statistical analysis for evaluation, ensure a realistic and hazard-free environment for participants. ○ The Little Family Pack (2 packs to be acquired) is a convenient pack of age-specific CPR training manikins with a wheeled carry bag for easy transport and storage. All are provided with QCPR feedback technology to help instructors improve the quality, efficiency, and learner engagement in CPR training. In accordance with current guidelines, they provide data on rate

	and depth of chest compressions, complete pressure relaxation, pause time and CPR ventilation through the new QCPR training apps, skills guide available via RC cable. ○ The Rapid Response Choking Training Vest (2 pieces to be acquired) is supplied with a built-in pad to allow practicing backstroke. This allows students to practice Heimlich maneuver techniques according to AHA and ERC standards. With the help of the vest, you can practice choking treatment skills at home. You can practice on your own at home using furniture, work tables. It is ideal for teachers, youth clubs, groups of scouts, parents and first aid instructors. ○ TRAINING VEST FOR QUICK RESPONSE (2 pieces to be acquired) in Case of Suffocation for children aged between 5 and 12 years: It is supplied with a pad for practicing backstroke if desired. This equipment is equipped with a guide for teachers that shows in detail how children should be prepared in terms of first aid training. First aid, resuscitation instructors can use this guide and this vest when providing pediatric training courses in the classroom, scout leaders, sports clubs, children's clubs, summer camps, babysitters and other groups that work with children. Community groups, voluntary ambulance services can develop their image within the local community with the help of the Training Vest for school-age children in demonstrations in local schools, malls, sports clubs, etc. Project vision is thus to achieve a high level of protection against disasters by preventing or reducing their potential effects, by improving CB resilience and cooperation between emergency situations stakeholders, based on intensified P2P sectorial actions.
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
